TBF: "Project v.1.24" Scholarship is dedicated to supporting students pursuing careers in medical imaging. This scholarship aims to recognize and empower future technologists in the field of medical imaging who demonstrate academic excellence and a commitment to advancing healthcare through innovative imaging technologies.

**Eligibility Criteria:**

1. Applicant is accepted to a program/degree in medical imaging in an accredited college or university.
2. Applicant must be a resident of the Middlesex County, MA.
3. Applicant must be 18 to 30 years old.
4. Applicants must submit a personal statement – three pages in length – detailing the significance of a recent photograph they've captured.

**Scholarship Award:**

1. The scholarship award amount is \$1098.00

**Application Process:**

1. Interested applicants must complete the online application form.
2. Applicants must submit all required documents, including:
  - Three-page personal statement addressing the specified prompt in MLA Formatting (double spaced, Times New Roman, 12 Font Size) with separate Work Cited page.
  - Official acceptance letter to a program/degree in medical imaging in an accredited college or university.
3. Applications must be submitted by the specified deadline to be considered for the scholarship.

**Deadline:**

1. The deadline for submitting applications for TBF: "Project v.1.24" Scholarship is Saturday August 31, 2024 by 11:11 PM.

**Selection Process:**

1. Scholarship recipient will be selected based on the content of their personal statement.

**Notification and Disbursement:**

1. Scholarship recipient will be notified via email or phone by Sunday September 1, 2024 at 11:11 AM.
2. Scholarship funds will be disbursed directly to the recipient's educational institution to cover tuition, fees, or other educational expenses related to their program in medical imaging.


